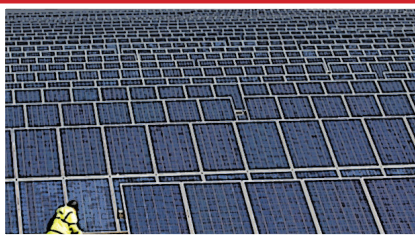
# GREEN BELT

**A planning application for a 79 acre solar farm development on green belt land, is currently with South Cambs District Council. If it goes ahead it will have a very significant impact on the landscape, wildlife and amenity that so many of us enjoy.**

## the FACTS



- The planned development will span **32 hectares (79 acres)** of GREEN BELT land to the South East of Thriplow. Equivalent to **45 football pitches** and is **five times the size of Heathfield**
- It will stretch **for one mile** - obscuring the view from our much-used Heathfield to Thriplow footpath as well as 'The Drift' Thriplow to Whittlesford path
- There will be thousands of **3 metre (9ft 10in)** panels plus numerous maintenance buildings, all surrounded by **security fencing** and **CCTV** cameras

We believe this is a **TOTALLY UNACCEPTABLE** use of green belt land and would have a **significant negative impact** on residents, the landscape, wildlife and the environment.
